



# Dress Code

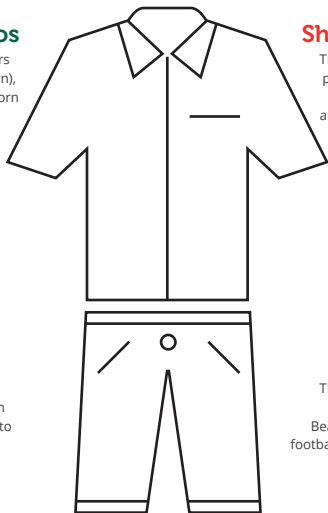
Members, their guests and club visitors are asked to respect the dress code on both courses and the practice areas. A proper attire is expected at the clubhouse especially during prize givings. Gentlemen must remove headwear inside the clubhouse.

## Gentlemen

Caps should be worn peak forwards.

### Shirts / Polos

Polo shirts with collars (traditional or modern), but these must be worn inside the waistband of your trousers or shorts.

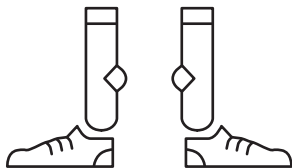


### Trousers & Shorts

The following are permitted: Full-length trousers, and shorts to mid-thigh or longer.

### Golf Shoes

Golf shoes only are permitted.



## Course and practice facilities Permitted / Not Permitted

### Shirts / Polos

The following are not permitted: Collarless polos and t-shirts, and rugby or football jerseys.

### Trousers & Shorts

The following are not permitted: Beach shorts, rugby or football shorts, blue jeans or tracksuits.

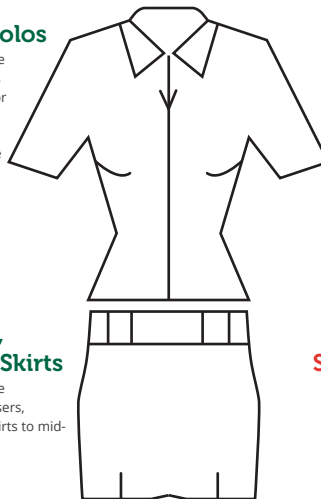
### Golf Shoes

The following are not permitted on the course: Trainers, casual shoes and street shoes.

## Ladies

### Shirts / Polos

The following are not permitted: Tank tops of any kind.



### Trousers, Shorts & Skirts

The following are not permitted: Beach shorts, rugby or football shorts, blue jeans or tracksuits.

### Golf Shoes

The following are not permitted on the course: Trainers, casual shoes and street shoes.

### Shirts / Polos

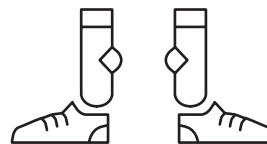
The following are permitted: Polos and shirts with or without sleeves may be worn inside or outside the waistband.
