



You can choose option (i) and since the last stroke was from the teeing area, you can use a tee. Or you can also choose option (ii) using A as a reference point.

Tee shot on 9 – Example 2 :

Even if your ball has not touched the ground on the fairway-side of the water, if it is certain that it has flown over land outside of the red stakes (as in the picture) you can choose option (iv) with B as your reference point. Options (i) and (ii) are also available. If the ball clears the water and comes to rest in the forest to the left, this zone is now also part of the red penalty area and the above 3 options are available.

Approach shot on 9 – Example 1 :

You can choose option (i) or option (ii) using A and the white line as reference or you can choose option (iii).

Approach shot on 9 – Example 2 :

You can choose option (i) or option (ii) using B and the white line as reference or you can choose option (iii).
